WHEN SHOULD DANCERS ARRIVE?

Arrive fifteen minutes before your scheduled time slot on stage. We may run ahead of schedule, so it is important to arrive early, dressed and ready in costume. We cannot wait for latecomers!

WHERE DO DANCERS GO?

Enter at the back of the school and go to the AUDITORIUM ready in costume. Once your dancer has finished their final routine of the day, they are free to leave. Parents are welcome to sit anywhere in the auditorium and watch during the rehearsal.

WHEN SHOULD DANCERS ARRIVE?

The theater doors open one half hour before the start of the show. Bring your dancer ready in costume with enough time for drop off and to find your seats.

WHERE DO DANCERS GO?

Signs with dressing room/waiting room assignments will be posted in the Rippowam lobby.
There will be Class Parents, Helpers and Teachers overseeing the students backstage and in the rooms.

NOTE TO THE PRE-K CREATIVE BALLET/TAP/JAZZ/TINY TOTS HIP HOP PARENTS: **Your child will be dismissed at intermission and must be picked up at that time from their class waiting room.** Your child is free to leave with you or sit with you for the remainder of the show. If your child wishes to participate in the finale, please report to the backstage area 3 songs before the end of the show.

**REMEMBER TO PRINT OUT YOUR TICKETS AS THEY
ARE REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION AND TO FIND YOUR SEATS!**

WHERE DO GUESTS GO?

Guests should proceed to the lobby with their ticket ready, and know which area their seat is located. There will be two entrances into the theater, one for odd and one for even-numbered seating (center section ticket holders may use either). Guests should follow signs to enter the appropriate line based on their ticket number and present ticket for admission.

WHAT IF GUESTS ARRIVE LATE?

As a courtesy to the audience and our dancers, the house doors will be shut after the show starts, and remain closed while the first five numbers are in progress. Doors will open briefly for latecomers and then will be shut again while numbers are in progress. Please be aware of when your dancer is performing so as not to miss it.

WHAT SHOULD DANCERS BRING?

Any costumes, accessories, shoes, etc. should be labeled, and valuables should be left at home. **We cannot be responsible for lost items.** If needed, dancers may bring water and light, non-messy snacks to their waiting rooms. No gum, and no food in the theater. **NOTE: DUE TO SOME OF OUR STUDENTS HAVING SEVERE NUT ALLERGIES, ANY SNACKS BROUGHT IN THE ROOMS MUST BE PEANUT AND TREE NUT-FREE.**
